## Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties School Registration

### REQUIREMENTS:

#### Eligibility

- ★ Kindergarten: Age 5 on or before September 1 (transfers from out-of-state may enroll)
- ★ Grade one: Age 6 on or before September 1 and completion of Kindergarten

#### Documents Needed

- ★ Birth Certificate
- ★ Proof of Residency
- ★ Proof of Custody (if not biological parent)
- ★ Last Report Card, IEP and last School Withdrawal Form
- ★ Health Screening Form

#### Vaccinations Needed

- ★ DtaP/DTP/TD - 4 or 5 doses
- ★ Polio - 3 or 4 doses
- ★ MMR - 2 doses
- ★ HEP B - 2 or 3 doses
- ★ Varicella - 2 doses
